The population of South Sudan is about 10 million people. More than 90% of people live on less than \$1 per day.

The maternal mortality rate is the highest in the world and child immunisation rate the lowest.

A girl has a higher chance of dying in childbirth than of finishing primary school.

Only 27% of girls are in school and there are 1000 primary school pupils per trained teacher.

There are only 10 certified midwives and 88 practising doctors in all of South Sudan.

97% of the population has no access to sanitation.

Polio, once eradicated has re-emerged.
